



Bird Feeder

Did you know that birds are an important part of the garden ecosystem?

Bird feeders allow birds to be seen up close, help birds feed their chicks, and provide them with energy to migrate.

Why don't we try building our own bird feeder?



WHAT WE NEED:

- lard
- various seeds
- a container (for example: a pine cone, half an orange skin, an empty yogurt pot, a finished toilet paper roll etc.)
- a string



STEP 1

We melt the lard in a small saucepan, pour in the seeds, stir everything well and let it cool.





We fill the container we chose with the lard and seed mixture.

STEP 3

We fasten the string to our container and hang our feeder from a tree, balcony railing or other spot easily reachable by the birds.
