



Scavenger hunt

Learning to become familiar with natural elements helps children better integrate and interact with their surroundings.

What better way to teach them than through the help of a fun game!



WHAT WE NEED:

- Lots of small natural objects (leaves, pebbles, sticks, flowers, feathers, etc.)
- A sheet of paper
- Pencil
- Colors
- A prize (for example, a nice box to store found treasures!)



STEP 1

Hide all the items you have collected around the garden (or house!).



STEP 2



Create a fun map to help children find treasures (instead of a map, it could also be small riddles).

STEP 3

Give the children the map and let them have fun finding all the natural treasures. And don't forget the final prize!
